Structure, governance and management

Type of governing document:

- Charity Commission Scheme including appointment of Trustees dated 15 February 1990.
Composition of the body of Trustees:
- The body of trustees shall consist when complete of seven competent persons being one ex-officio trustee, three nominated trustees and three co-opted trustees. The nominated trustees shall be appointed for a term of 4 years and the co-opted trustees for a term of 5 years.

Objects of the charity set out in its governing body

The area of benefit is the area of the Ecclesiastical Parish of St. Mark, Teddington and St. John the Baptist, Hampton Wick, together with St. Mary with St. Alban in Teddington.

Subject to the payment of the expenses of management, the Trustees shall pay out of the yearly income of the Charity a sum of not less than £50 and not more than £1,000 or such other amount as may be approved by the Commissioners to the Parochial Church Council of the existing Ecclesiastical Parish of St. Mark, Teddington and St. John the Baptist, Hampton Wick, for application by that council in or towards the maintenance and upkeep of the Church of St. John the Baptist in that ecclesiastical parish.

Provided that if at any time the Church Commissioners establish a pastoral scheme which creates a new ecclesiastical parish and as a result of which the said church is situated therein then the Trustees shall pay the said sum to the parochial Church Council of the new ecclesiastical parish for application by that council in like manner.

Subject thereto the Trustees shall apply the said income as follows:-

- (a) One third thereof for the promotion of education in the area of benefit, in accordance with various provisions further detailed; and
- (b) Two thirds for relief in need, also with various provisions further detailed.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

The Trustees met twice: in October 2020 and in January 2021. The meeting in July 2020 was cancelled due to coronavirus lockdown measures.

Historically, income for the charity has come from just three sources – rent from property, from dividends from investments and from bank interest.

The Charity owns a commercial property in Walton-on-Thames, purchased in June 2016 at a cost of £657,404. Rents received in the year 2020/21 amounted to £31,894 (previous year: £42,291). Due to the coronavirus lockdown from March 2020, the tenants were allowed a three month rent "holiday".

Dividends received were £11,450 (2019-20: £10,923) and interest from investments was £186 (2019-20: £957).

No grant was again paid to St John & St Mark PCC (£5,000 had been granted in the year 2013-14). Out of the residue of income received, £8,764 (2019-20: £26,538) was donated from the Promotion of Education Fund and £12,906 from the Relief in Need Fund (2019-20: £8,124). Out of the Relief in Need Fund, £2,200 was donated to individuals in need; £6,450 to other organisations and £400 as Christmas gifts to former Normansfield residents. £3,856 was paid for the hire of the Bullen Hall for the use of the Good Fellowship Club in 2019-2020. As the Club could not meet in the Hall for the year 2020-21 due to coronavirus restrictions, no payments will be made for this.

The Trustees are aware of the implications of sections 28, 29, 30 and 32 of the Constitution of 1990 regarding application of income and can state that they believe that they are not in breach of them. However, the Trustees are intending to review this matter at their next Meeting.

Financial Review

Cash balances at the bank and COIF at 31st March 2021 totalled £95,853 (2020: £171,964).

The Charity also holds 17,355 COIF units worth at financial year end £311,106 (2020: £178,556) and M&G Charifund , BLK Charities UK Equity Fund and BLK Charities UK Bond Fund units valued in total at £124,803 (2020: £100,995).


Reserves Policy
