The trust again received significant gifts during the financial year which enabled it to provide additional support to key projects outlined below, and to provide a substantial reserve for future activities. |
| Summary of the main activities in relation to those purposes for the public benefit, in particular, the activities, projects or services identified in the accounts. | Para 1.17 and 1.19 | <p>The trust has continued to support the distribution of Christian literature in countries where it has reliable contacts and where the recipients could not otherwise afford such material. These countries include India and Russia.</p> <p>In some cases the trust has also made gifts to known individuals for the relief of their own or of others' poverty. This has included many of our contacts who live in communities that have been severely impacted by Covid-19 and subsequent economic difficulties. In Africa, India and elsewhere, believers and others have been without work and have struggled to obtain food and life's necessities. Support from the relevant state authorities was often unavailable. Throughout the year the trust was able to reach out, often proactively, to our contacts and provide funds to help relieve the immediate needs.</p> |
