BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES

The charity was established under a scheme by order of the Charity Commissioners from insurance proceeds of a former school. The objects of the charity are to provide items, services, facilities and special benefits not normally provided from some other source for the pupils of Hunslet Church of England School and any Church of England voluntary aided or grant maintained school in the Anglican deanery of Armley.

The current agreed grant level is £18,500 per academic year per eligible school. There are currently two eligible schools being Hunslet Church of England School and Beeston St Luke School.

ACTIVITIES DURING THE YEAR

The Armley Deanery Schools Charity (1014754) ('the Trust') gave grants during the year in accordance with the purposes of the Trust's objectives to the value of £37,000 (2022: £37,000).

Dividends and interest received during the year amounted to £41,182 (2022: £40,597) giving a surplus of receipts over payments of £4,182 (2020: £3,597 surplus).

The investments showed an unrealised gain in the year of £133,035 (2022: £182,394 loss).

Total funds at the end of the year were £1,534,663 (2022: £1,397,446)

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The Leeds Diocesan Board of Finance (LDBF) is the managing trustee of the Trust. During 2023 grant applications were received and reviewed by the Leeds Diocesan Board of Education.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICY

Basis of accounting

The financial statements are prepared under the historic cost convention as modified by the revaluation of investments in accordance with applicable accounting standards and the Statement of Recommended Practice for Charities.

Investments

Investments are stated at Bid Market Value. Realised and Unrealised gains/losses are reflected in the statement of Financial Activities.

Reserves

The reserves policy is to maintain a deposit account balance which equates to one academic years' worth of grant payments. Given that this is equivalent to £37,000 in line with the current agreed grants and should not ordinarily exceed the annual income, free reserves are significantly above the required level.
