DESCRIPTION OF THE CHARITY:

Objectives

- (a) To preach and teach the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to the Holy Scriptures through open-air crusades, in-door revival services, mass media and pulpit ministry.
- (b) To publish books, treatises, tracts and magazines of the Church in furtherance of (a) above;
- (c) To cater for members of the Church by forming and establishing assemblies and also through planned programmes;
- (d) To promote sincere love and mutual respect among its members and to be at peace with all men;
- (e) To establish schools for the education of members' children and others as may like to attend such schools;
- (f) To provide facilities, including bible schools, for the moral and spiritual education of members and workers.

INVESTMENT POWER: In furtherance of our objectives but not otherwise the Charity may exercise the following powers:

1. to draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue promissory notes, bills, cheques and other instruments, and to operate bank accounts in the name of the Charity.

3. provided that in raising funds the charity shall not undertake any substantial permanent trading activities and shall conform to any relevant statutory regulations.

ACTIVITIES:

OUR MAIN PROJECTS:

Our activities as charity include the following:

Youth development programme:

This programme provides opportunities for the various ethnic youth groups to interact and build community cohesion considering the racial challenges experienced in recent times.

Counselling:

This programme provides free counselling for people in and around borough of Southwark on various issues affecting families and individuals, most especially the **youths** within the borough and its environs.

Day Care Centre:

Providing Parents and Toddler Group Day Care Centre as part of the government strategy to assist mothers back into employment.

- **Summer Schemes**
- **After school club**
- **Saturday school/homework club**
- **Care Training Provider**
Helping elderly or people with learning disabilities live their lives.
- **Employment and Skills Training**
Basic training; such as short courses and taster sessions, i.e. confidence building, etc.

We are presently not able to continue with some of the above listed activities due to lack of adequate facility. We hope to continue from where we stopped as soon as we are able to secure a permanent building.

INTERNATIONAL OUTREACH/EVANGELISM AND MISSION DEVELOPMENT

As part of our charity outreach and mission's activities, Wall of Praise Christian Centre embarked fully on mission to the rural areas in West Africa, Nigeria in 2016.

Our first place of operation is in the rural area of Ogun state, Nigeria.

On arrival at Orile-Oko Community High School (OCHS), Isan Araromi, Remo North Local Government, which serves the entire 35 villages in Orile-Oko with over 200 students, I found out that there was no adequate toilet, well water or tap water in the entire school.

During the course of my discussion with the principal of the school, Mr. Oladimeji, who made me realized that he had just been transferred to the school, and that they had started appealing to people like us in the country and outside the country for assistance at least to have ordinary deep well for his students and his staff members.

In 2016, members of Wall of Praise Christian Centre, London UK, unanimously agreed to embark on Africa rural area development project in one of the secondary schools in a far remote village in Remo North

Local Government, Ogun state Nigeria. The first face of the charity's project includes the building of modern toilets, digging of an industrial borehole, plumbing works, supply of water tanks, pumping machine and generator, etc.

In May 2016, myself and two members of Wall of Praise Christian Centre trustees, Rev. Stephen Popoola and Mrs. Abigail Adegboyega flew to Nigeria to present the above-mentioned completed facilities to Orile-Okoko Community High School, Isan Araromi, Orile-Okoko, Remo North Local government, Ogun state, Nigeria.

On Saturday May 2016, the above-mentioned facilities were commissioned by the representatives of Ogun State Commissioner for Education, Zonal Education Officer, Remo Local Government, principals of secondary schools in Ogun state, parents of the students from 35 villages and other dignitaries from the UK, Lagos state, Abeokuta, Ijebu Ogun state, Ibadan Oyo state etc.

In May 2017, Wall of Praise Christian Centre went back to Orile-Okoko Community High School to furnish the school library with (4 copies each) of all the books used in secondary school in Nigeria and with adequate reading furnitures.

In October 2017, Wall of Praise Christian Centre extended her rural area charity works to Lalupon town, Lagelu Local Government, Oyo State where 5 Water Deep Wells were constructed and donated to the people of that community.

Two additional deep wells were constructed in 2017, one at St. Peter's Primary School, Ajana, Orile-Okoko, Remo North Local Government, Ogun State, while the second-deep well was donated to one family in Ibadan, Oyo State, Nigeria.

In appreciation of the support we're given toward the development of education in Ogun State, Wall of Praise Christian Centre, under the leadership of Rev. Samson A. Adegboyega was nominated for a Merit Award by All Nigeria Confederation of Principals of Secondary Schools, (ANCOPSS), Ogun State on 26th November 2016. And on the 2nd August 2018, I received another Award of Excellence from the Ogun State Teaching Service Commission, on behalf of Wall of Praise Christian Centre.

In addition to the above, Wall of Praise Christian Centre purchased an acre of land in Abeokuta where our International Secretariat will be

situated and where several other activities for both young and old who need help would be carried out.

Wall of Praise purchased a piece of land at Lalupon, Lagelu Local Government, Ibadan, Oyo State to build a Centre for the youths in that community and its environs. The construction of the building started in February 2019 and by may ending 2019, the building was roofed while other internal and external works have since then been put on hold due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Presently, WOPCC does not have a place of worship due to the closure of the Southwark Council's Tenants Association Hall we've been using for our weekly meetings before Covid-19.

We hope to embark on some of the above-mentioned project as soon as we secure a suitable accommodation for our organization in the nearest future.
