- daily five times prayers are held every day
- friday prayers are held every week
- madrasah classes are held every day during evenings to teach Islamic studies
- Islamic weddings (Nikah) ceremonies are provided to the wider community.
- adjacent building has been purchased and is in the process of being refurbished.
