Para 1.20	<p>We have continued funding 2 main residential homes for children &amp; teenagers who have decided to leave the streets, one for boys and one for girls with an average of 15 boys and 6 girls in these homes through the year.</p> <p>The reintegration house has had a total of 4 residents this year continuing with their higher education.</p> <p>Work has continued with street teams offering basic first aid and healthcare and encouraging young people to leave the streets.</p> <p>3 new girls and 4 new boys were received into the homes but only 1 girl and 3 boys stayed.</p> <p>We also had one young man become independent from our reintegration home having completed his career in football coaching.</p>

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
