The school is now called The William de Yaxley Church of England Academy.</p>

Religious instruction in accordance with the principles and doctrines of the Church of England shall be given at the School subject to the provisions of the Education Acts.</p> <p>The income shall be applied:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(1) By making such payments as are necessary (including in relation to the discharge of any obligations under the Educations Acts with respect to the maintenance of the school; and(2) In or towards providing such special benefits of any kind not normally provided by Government (national or local) for the School as may from time to time be agreed by the Trustee.
