Para 1.20	<p>Conditions this year prevented us from achieving our aim of preserving our capital in line with inflation and distributing our income. We are considering during the current year how we can react to this situation.</p> <p>Nevertheless during last year we made 40 grants totalling £85,818. Most of these were of less than £5,000 to assist in the funding of small charities within our area of operation.</p> <p>Local charities at present seem reluctant to start new ventures and none of the applications we received appeared to qualify for the larger donations we are prepared to make to pump prime the start of worthwhile new charitable initiatives.</p> <p>It has been our policy for many years to place the great majority of our investment funds under the management of a single investment house, but at the end of the year, we decided to change this policy and to place a substantial sum with two large charitable investment funds. This changeover overlapped the year end and resulted in us having an unusually large cash balance at that time.</p> <p><i>Arnold Denman, Chairman</i></p>
