TRUSTEES REPORT

The Charity's objects ('the Objects') are to: -

(a) Advance the education of the public in aviation history, heritage and culture in Ireland by:

- (i) The establishment and maintenance of an aviation museum for the collection, preservation, conservation, restoration, explanation, interpretation and display of artefact, memorabilia, maps, historical records, books, photographs and other documents;

(c) Promote such other charitable purposes as may from time to time be determined.
