I report, as an Independent Examiner, on the accounts of Africare for the year ended 5<sup>th</sup> April 2023.

As trustees, you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the Charities Act (Northern Ireland) 2008

It is my responsibility to:

- Examine the accounts under section 65 of the Charities Act
- Follow the procedures laid down in the General Directions given by the Commission under section 65(9) (b) of the Charities Act and to state if any matters have come to my attention
