

Independent examiner's report to the charity trustees of Food for Thought Africa for the year ended 5 April 2023

I report on the accounts of the Trust for the year ended 5 April 2023, which are set out on pages 7 to 10.

Respective responsibilities of charity trustees and examiner

As the charity's trustees you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the Charities Act (Northern Ireland) 2008.

Basis of independent examiner's report

I have examined your charity accounts as required under section 65 of the Charities Act and my examination was carried out in accordance with the general Directions given by the Charity Commission for Northern Ireland under section 65(9)(b) of the Charities Act.

My examination included a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. 4. That there is further information needed for a proper understanding of the accounts to be reached.
