Objectives and Activities

To promote the benefit of the inhabitants of Burren and surrounding area without distinction of gender, sexual orientation, age, race, ethnicity, or political, religious or other opinion by associating with the statutory authorities, voluntary and community organisations and inhabitants in a common effort to:

- (a) promote amateur sport and participation in healthy recreation with the aim of improving their health and well being.
- (b) provide facilities in the interests of social welfare for recreation and other leisure time occupations with the object of improving the conditions of life for those living in the area of benefit;
- (c) promote community development by providing facilities and support for community and voluntary groups and organisations and encouraging and assisting such organisations to co-operate to achieve their aims;
- (d) relieve those in need by reason of youth, age, ill-health, disability or other disadvantage;
- (e) advance education and training;
- (f) promote good community relations and social cohesion, racial harmony and equality and diversity.

Achievements and Performance

Burren Vision has made a significant contribution since 2014 to improving the levels of physical development and education of adults and young people within the Burren Area. The charity continues to secure funding for future services and infrastructure in a bid to roll out such services.

Financial Review

The Charity recorded Net Incoming Resources of £82K for the year ended 31st March 2024 which has been taken to the Income and Expenditure Account. Expenditure of £62k on Activities for Generating Funds has also been taken to the Income and Expenditure Account leaving a Net Surplus for the year of £19k. The Charity therefore recorded Net Reserves at 31st March 2023 of £43,720 (2022: £23,797).

Governing Document


