OBJECTIVE AND ACTIVITIES

OBJECTIVES: the group is established to advance education and to preserve and protect health of school-age children in Ballygawley area and its environs in this surrounding rural location by the provision of educational and recreational facilities out of school hours in the interests of social welfare without distinction of gender, ethnic identity, nationality, religions, political or other opinion.

MAIN ACTIVITIES: to raise funds and support the work of Richmond Primary School for all children who attend the out-of-hours activity as well as during school hours.

ADDITIONAL DETAIL: the management committee meet once a term (three times per year) to discuss and implement fundraising ideas in conjunction with the school principle. They also hold an Annual General Meeting.

PUBLIC BENEFIT

This promotes improved health and wellbeing outcomes, increased social inclusion, reduces anxieties and increases socialising, cooperation, good community relations, skills and confidence which will improve circumstances and opportunities.

There is no harm anticipated from this purpose. The charity's beneficiaries are primarily all the children who attend Richmond primary school.
