

INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEE'S OF
ST. PATRICK'S BOWLING CLUB

My report is related to the accounts for the year ended 4th April 2022.
I have examined the Club/Charity accounts as required under section 65 of the Charities Act and my examination was carried out in accordance with the general Directions given by the Charity Commission for Northern Ireland under section 65 (9) (b) of the Charities Act.

My examination included a review of the accounting records kept by the Club and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records.
It also included consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from you as Club Trustees concerning any such matters.
