Dungoyne FC AGM Meeting 8th July 2022

Meeting started 7.20pm

1. Chairperson Remarks

Chairperson Ian McKee welcomed everyone and checked attendance sheet had been signed by all in attendance. Chairperson thanked all coaches for their time, hard work and commitment over the last 12 months. The main point for 2022/23 season was that all coaches need to work together for the club as a whole unit and not to solely focus and concentrate on individual sections/age groups.

Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Darren McKnight explained that it has been a challenging year financially following Covid-19 pandemic which impacted greatly on our main external sponsor. He is hopeful that re-engagement with this sponsor will greatly ease the financial pressure we find ourselves under as a club.

Team Fee Pay (TFP) will need to be reviewed by incoming committee with consideration needed around increasing the monthly payment and how strictly the club manage those who are in or fall into arrears through TFP. Darren stated the club would continue to subsidise coach education as far as possible, again a decision would need to be made by incoming committee to agree on the financial support that can be provided, and by which means (potential funding).

Secretary Remarks

Secretary Davy Livingstone reemphasised the points made by Chairperson and treasurer and stated that it was vital that all coaches and age groups/sections work together going forward for the benefit of the club. Davy also told all attendees that in general, the behaviour of teams and coaches had been exemplary with no reports of concern from governing bodies. Davy thanked his fellow committee members and everyone in attendance.

2. Election of New Committee

Ian McKee asked Roy Allen to temporarily take the chair for election of the new committee. Davy Livingstone stayed to record the nominations and results for all positions. This process took place and is attached
