Finally, my thanks go to all of you for continuing to pull together and allowing the Church to continue to pay our way.

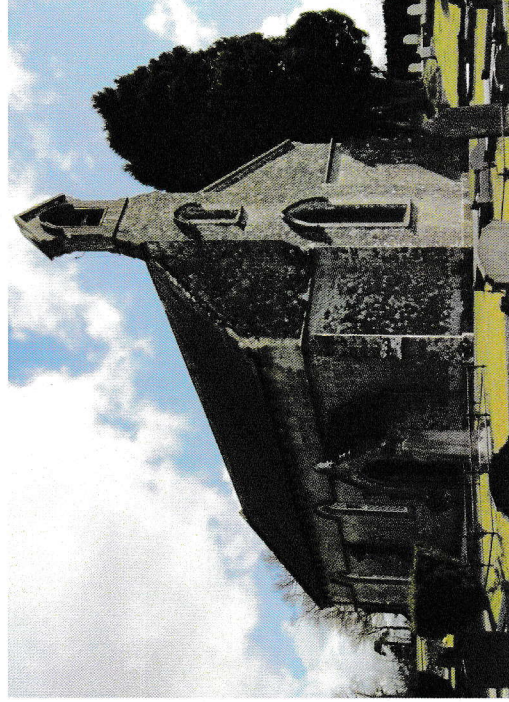

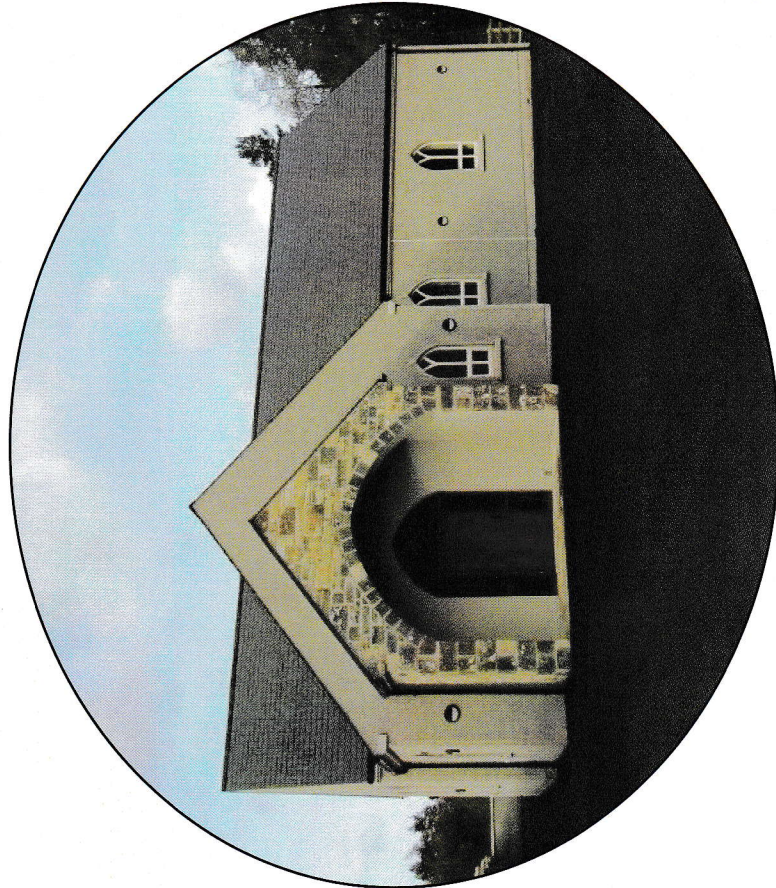
