In evaluating Public Benefit the trustees note that Mullaghduin Community Association provide a range of Educational, social and recreational activities within the local area based in Mullaghduin Community Centre. The services and facilities in the Community Centre are made available to all those living in the area, as well to all cross border and cross community groups.

Summary of Main Activities

During the year 1/4/23-31/3/23 our community association received our annual grant from the Ora Beg wind farm, the total amount for this year was £8770.57 and was used for the benefit of our community in a number of ways:

We organised a refresher training for 12 people in the community in October, this also incorporated First aid training on a general basis and was delivered by a registered nurse from a neighbouring community, we hope to continue with this event on an annual basis.

We had a coffee morning after church in April also for the community. A few repairs were carried out on our exit doors and wooden floor which was damaged by a water leak. We priced painting of the exterior which will be carried out later in the summer months.

A tidy up both inside and outside was carried out, deep cleaning of the main hall, power hosing the entire outside area and tarmacking the car park spaces in the hall surroundings.

In December 2023 we had a lovely evening of flower arranging where we were able to watch Christmas Wreathes being made. We also ran our annual Bazaar for our youth club which was up and running from September to April.

We had our community Christmas draw and coffee morning the week before Christmas which was very well attended, with a gift from Santa for every child and many prizes for all.

Our hall was used for many events including a bowling competition, private parties and funeral meals as well as dance classes, yoga, band practice, local talent show and story- telling evening and youth club.
