



#### **Objectives and Activities/Charitable Objects**

As set out in our constitution our association promotes the benefits of the inhabitants of Mullaghduin, without discrimination, to advance education, citizenship and community developments, therefore improving their conditions of life.

#### **Public Benefit Statement**

In evaluating Public Benefit the trustees note that Mullaghduin Community Association provides a range of educational, social and recreational activities within the local area based in Mullaghduin community centre. The services and facilities in the community centre are made available to all those living in the area, as well to all cross border and cross community groups.

In 2023/2024 our youth club continued between October and April with 54 members. Our annual grant from the Ora Beg Windfarm which totalled £9,532.91 allowed us to carry out necessary repairs, such as painting the exterior of the building. We replaced the batteries in our defibrillator and carried out annual training of its use and a first aid refresher course for all of the committee. Fire safety training was given and all necessary fire checks completed. Our varied classes during the week included hip hop, pilates, yoga and country/set dance classes.

A flower arrangement demonstration took place in November and our annual Christmas events including a bazaar, coffee morning and a visit from Santa took place in December. We made a donation of £500 to two very worthy local charities: a local food bank and SWELL, a cancer support group. Our local council supplied us with a grant which allowed us to plant four trees around the community centre. We also purchased a bench, which faces out onto our adjoining cemetery.
