We had our annual Guide Residential weekend at Lorne where Guides took part in activities such as Zip Line, Archery, Bushcraft and plenty of outdoor activities.

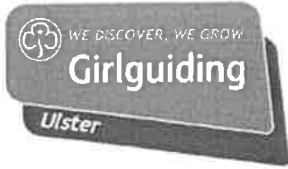
We also take part in the Royal British legion Remembrance Parade to the cenotaph.
