The trustees of The HSE Catherwood Family Charitable Trust are pleased to submit their report and accounts for the period 1st January 2021 to 31st December 2021.

Purpose.

The trust's purpose is the provision of grants to UK registered charities who carry out their work in any part of the world.

When issuing grants for the year the trustees have given careful consideration to the Charity Commission for Northern Ireland's guidance on public benefit to ensure that the beneficiaries have helped to achieve the charity's purposes and provide public benefit.

Beneficiary

Total donations of £20,000 were made in the period.

Black Santa – Belfast Cathedral – £ 10,000 on 8th January 2021 . £ 10,000 on 15th December 2021

"All the money gathered is donated to local charities with a proportion given to Christian Aid. The charities supported are those with an annual income of £150,000 or less. The Black Santa Appeal focuses support for those local charities giving support on the front line of the "cost of living crisis", and also charities working with refugee communities in support of those who have found sanctuary among us, those from Ukraine to Syria to Afghanistan. Other charities supported work in the fields of medical research; those caring for children, youth and the elderly; the improvement of employment opportunities for young people and a host of small charities which cannot afford paid fund-raisers. All the funds raised in the days before Christmas are distributed to charities at the Good Samaritans' Service, held in the Cathedral early in the year following each Sit-out."

Financial Summary

Grants totalling £20,000 were made from total income of £8,570.76. This compares to Zero grants out of £ 10,580.57 income in the previous period.

Retained funds decreased from £ 47,998.90 at the end of 2020 to £ 36,569.66 this year end.

The trustees are satisfied with the investment's performance and the income it generates. There were no costs incurred in the year.
