The period started with £292.34 in the bank and petty cash of £42.10 and ended the period with funds of £392.11. There are no debts and the running balance is needed to allow for purchases of materials to be made over the summer before 2024/25 income is received. In the financial year to 30 June 2024, there was total income of £2,559.04 and expenditure of £2,501.37.

The accounts for the period ended 30 June show a surplus of £57.67.
