

## **Trustees report for Origin Bible Trust.**

For year 1/5/22 to 30/4/23.

The ongoing effects of the Covid restrictions made it difficult to use the exhibition for the first part of this period, but there was more confidence for schools and public events by 2023.

We were in schools by invitation and a public venue in the Co Londonderry.

When in schools classes were conducted around the exhibition in age appropriate tour. At other times it was open to the public and visitors were encouraged to browse the exhibition at their leisure, with the trustees on hand to answer questions.

Feedback from teachers was very positive, both in the content of the exhibition and how those explaining it to children were able to relate to each age group. It was also noted that the content of the exhibition fitted closely in with the national RE curriculum.

No charge was made for the exhibition and there were no collection boxes used or appeal for donations. The trust did not do any fund raising.


