

3.Independent Examiner's Report 2023/2024

I have made examined The Russian Speaking Community Northern Ireland Accounts for the financial year 2023/2024 ended 30 June 2024.

Respective responsibilities of charity trustees and examiner

As the charity's trustees you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the Charities Act (Northern Ireland) 2008. It is my responsibility to:

Basis of independent examiner's report

I have examined your charity accounts as required under section 65 of the Charities Act and my examination was carried out in accordance with the general Directions given by the Charity Commission for Northern Ireland under section 65(9)(b) of the Charities Act.

My examination included a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also included consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeking explanations from you as charity trustees concerning any such matters.

My role is to state whether any material matters have come to my attention giving me cause to believe:

1. That accounting records were not kept in accordance with section 63 of the Charities Act
2. That the accounts do not accord with those accounting records
3. That the accounts do not comply with the accounting requirements of the Charities Act
4. That there is further information needed for a proper understanding of the accounts to be reached.

Independent examiner's statement

I have completed my examination and have no concerns in respect of the matters (1) to (4) listed above and, in connection with following the Directions of the Charity Commission for Northern Ireland, I have found no matters that require drawing to your attention.

All entries in the RSCNI accounts were checked with Bank Statements.

Donation received (£108.00),
Expenditure (£ 21,557.65),
Grants received 23/24 (£8,753.40),
Grants expenditure (£10,047.50) was verified is correct.
The bank closing balance of (£ 10,402.12) is correct.

No irregular items nor any discrepancies were found.

The expenditure details confirm that the objectives of the RSCNI have been met.
