### Achievements and performance

The objects of the Trust shall be to distribute and pay all money and other assets of the Charity (whether capital or income) to the District Scout Council or the Corporation used by that Council or the Corporation for its charitable purposes in the operation or improvement of the premises known as Ardnally, Belfast, and to be used as far as possible for the enhancement in value and usefulness of the said premises for the advancement of Scouting.

The upkeep and development of Ardnally Scout Centre projects funded by the Jimmy Glenn Memorial Trust have improved the site and buildings. The Trust has paid for central heating, access improvements, replacement windows, a new play trail.

Unfortunately, no funding requests were received before the end of the 2023/24 financial year as a result no payments were made. A request is expected early in the 2024/25 financial year.

### Financial review

The valuation of the Trust's investments held with Evelyn Partners increased from £164,096 at 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023 to £184,774.00 at 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024.
