Connect Fermanagh Independent Examiner's Report

Year ended 31st March 2025

I report on the accounts of the company for the year ended 31st March 2024, which are set out on page 8.

Respective responsibilities of charity trustees and examiner

Basis of independent examiner's report

4. That there is further information needed for a proper understanding of the accounts to be reached.
